Situation

- **The Superior Court of California, Los Angeles County (LACSC)** is the largest single unified trial court in the United States and handles many of America's most high-profile cases. With 5,400 employees and an annual budget of \$769.5 million, the superior court operates nearly 600 courtrooms throughout the county.
- LACSC wanted to ensure they are setting up their cloud environment according to best practices so it could support their organization for years to come. They also wanted to reduce their reliance on datacenters, several of which are reaching capacity, as well as reduce overhead costs by migrating away from on premises.
- LACSC recognized the advantage of leveraging this opportunity to bolster the information about their environment so they could further enhance their operational efficiencies.

Solution

- LACSC chose to incorporate an assessment and engage Quisitive to conduct an Azure Migration leveraging AMMP funding from Microsoft to migrate 300-500 servers currently residing across 3 datacenters
- Following initial discovery and alignment sessions with LACSC, Quisitive will establish their Azure Landing Zone and set up components such as subscriptions, identity, networking, management, security, and governance policies to ensure LACSC has a strong foundation for growth within the Azure cloud.
- From there, the migration will be broken down into 5 waves of roughly 100 servers, where Quisitive will also provide application coordination, testing, and cutover and go live support.
- Concurrently, the Quisitive team will also develop their CMBD pipeline, reducing costs for LACSC because so much of the information that needs to be gathered to begin this project will easily be augmented during the discovery phase of the AMMP migration engagement.

Next Steps

- Quisitive's engagements with LACSC will continue through mid-November 2021.
- Quisitive will leverage the analysis and engagement to help LACSC accelerate their journey of modernization with Azure at its core.

Impact

- Not only does LACSC decrease their reliance and overhead costs associated with datacenters by migrating their environment to the cloud, but they were able to accelerate the creation of their CMBD build by building in tandem with their migration and leveraging Quisitive, a partner already familiar with their environment and specific needs, for a second time.
